The Sanlam Escalating fund invests in the corresponding SIM General Equity Fund and cash. When the performance of the SIM General Equity decreases, the percentage allocated to cash will increase. When the performance of the fund increases, the percentage in cash will decrease and the percentage in the SIM General Equity Fund will increase.

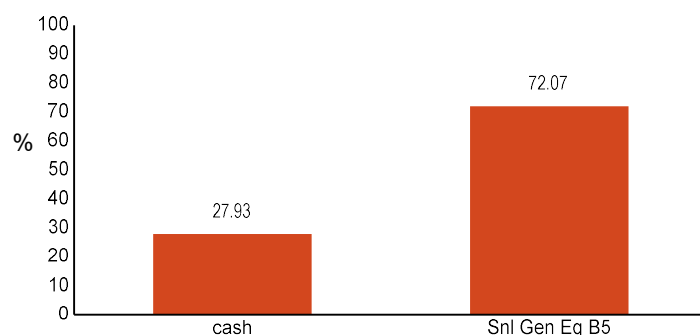
