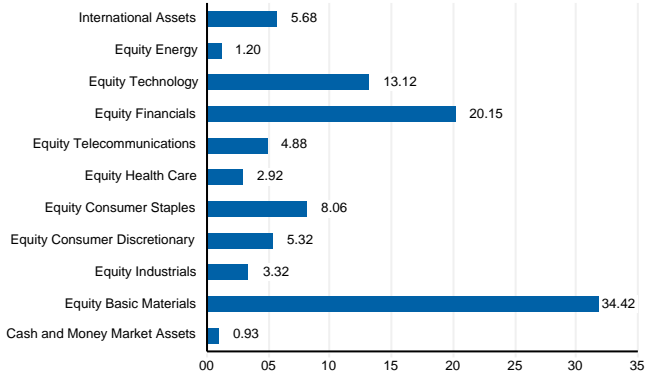

**Risk Profile (Aggressive)**
