The fund aims to achieve its stated investment objective by investing in a diversified portfolio of instruments across a variety of different asset classes. The instruments in which the fund invests are selected on the basis of proprietary multi-asset trading strategies of the Investment Manager as further detailed below. The application of these trading strategies may result in the fund investing in the underlying instruments on a long/short basis.

Fund objective and policy

The fund will invest in equities, fixed income securities such as corporate and government bonds (which may be fixed or floating rate and rated investment or sub-investment grade by Standard & Poor's, Moody's or an equivalent rating agency), money market instruments such as investment grade corporate bonds and government issued securities of less than 1 year maturity, cash deposits, collective investment schemes ("CIS") and exchange traded funds ("ETF"). The fund will also invest in FDI in the form of futures (including equity index futures) and options in order to gain indirect exposure to these instruments and asset classes.

Effective annual cost

The Effective Annual Cost (EAC) is a measure which has been introduced to allow you to compare the cost you incur when you invest in different financial products.
